Put this date in your diary. A real fun night with prizes and competitions as well as the excitement of the Bingo....Now which Teacher has the loudest voice???

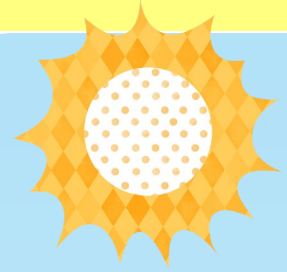
