



# The Four Pillars of our **CURRICULUM**



## 1. Development of the Child

- We focus on nurturing pupils' values, knowledge, and skills so they flourish and make a positive difference in their community and beyond.
- Our emphasis is on life-long learning, social attitudes (tolerance, respect, conflict resolution) and global citizenship (respecting human rights, gender equality, justice).
- Our learning is designed to be authentic, real-life and local, so children see relevance in their island context and the wider world.

## 2. Entitlement



- At Bel Royal every pupil is entitled to an engaging, creative, inclusive curriculum that provides opportunities for challenge.
- Our curriculum is based on the Jersey Curriculum but tailored to reflect the island's rich heritage, environment, and economic needs.
- We ensure consistency across the school and high expectations for all learners.



## 3. Equity

- Our curriculum is designed to promote inclusiveness and fairness, ensuring all pupils (regardless of background or need) can access learning.
- It supports high expectations for all children, removing barriers to learning so all can succeed.
- It encourages respect for diversity, and caring for self, others, and the environment.

- Our curriculum is aspirational and progressive, so learning is outward-facing: children are encouraged to become well-rounded, confident, empathetic, independent learners.
- Teachers plan around core knowledge from the Jersey Curriculum framework, but design exciting, stimulating lessons that build knowledge, skills and understanding.
