Welcome back to your child's last term in Nursery!

We cannot believe how quickly this year has gone by and have lots of exciting learning planned in Nursery for this Summer Term. We are planning a trip called 'Rockpool Rambles' on Wednesday 3rd July to La Rocque – more details to follow!

Physical Development



We will be providing opportunities to move in lots of different ways – running, skipping, jumping, hopping etc. We will develop our skills of throwing and catching too!

We will continue to develop our fine motor skills using one handed tools such as scissors and pencils for drawing and writing. The children will be expected to hold their pencil correctly in Reception and use it with good control. It is important to build up the muscles in arms and little fingers by doing lots of threading, using tweezers, rolling playdough and building with smaller construction.



Understanding the World

We will be looking for signs of summer and developing our understanding of sun safety.

We will be spending time in our garden planting, growing and taking care of all living things including the minibeasts we find there! As well as rockpooling at La Rocque beach. We will be looking at and understanding how some families have similar everyday routines and interests, and also developing an awareness of some differences between ourselves and other families.

Mathematics



We will be providing meaningful and varied opportunities for comparing length, weight capacity and time by making good use of our Nursery garden. We will continue to develop our concept of number, in particular matching numerals to quantities and comparing groups of objects. We have become super subitisers in Nursery and can recognise how many objects we can see without counting them. Please practise this at home!

Communication and Language

We will share books on a daily basis and continue to learn and enjoy poems and rhymes.

We will be talking and sharing our news with our friends and developing our listening skills. Children should be able to use a range of tenses when communicating e.g. I play, I played, I am playing.



RWI Phonics & Literacy

We will continue the Read Write Inc. Phonics scheme in Nursery. The children are taught to say the sounds of letters with the help of mnemonics. This term they will be introduced to 'Fred' who is a RWI character who can only speak in individual sounds! 'Fred Talk' is an activity that occurs in every Speed Sound lesson and helps children form the foundations for reading and spelling.

Please help your child to practise recognising and saying the pure sounds at home and repeating the mnemonics. The website below has lots of excellent videos for parents.

This term we will be drawing and writing in a range of media inside and outside Nursery. It is important that your child sees you writing for all sorts of purposes e.g. shopping lists, cards, notes.
